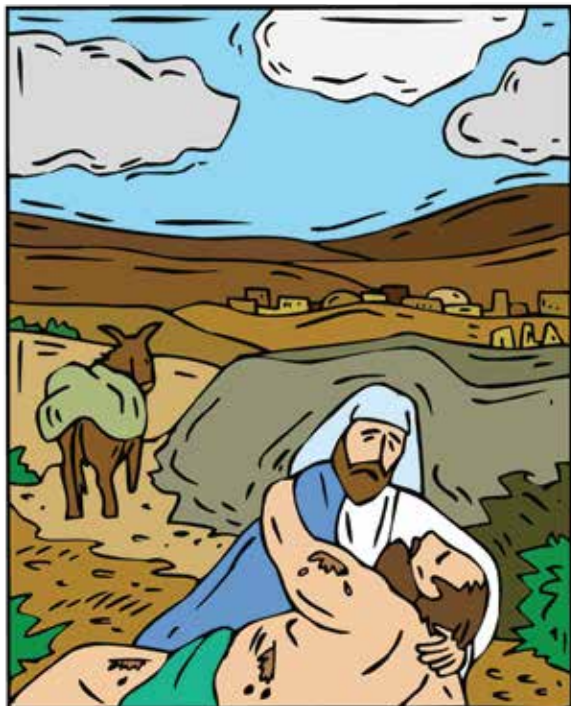


# A 'Good' Scramble
