

Break the Code - An Eye for an Eye

In Matthew 5:38-42, Jesus teaches us the importance of not taking revenge. To discover Jesus' full message to us and break the code, look at each letter and write the letter that follows that letter in the alphabet. For example, FNC would be the code word for GOD. If the letter is "Z" the letter that follows would be "A". (From the New Living Translation)
