

# Forgiveness

LUKE 15:11-32

In Luke 15:11-32, Jesus tells the parable of the Prodigal Son. In this story, the older son stays home to work on his father's land while the younger son takes his inheritance, leaves home, and wastes all his money. Then he realizes how badly he's behaved, returns home and apologizes to his father. Instead of being angry, the father forgives him and celebrates his return by having a party.

This parable teaches us that no matter what bad thing we do or that happens to us, God will always forgive us. Think of a time when you forgave someone instead of staying upset, and answer the questions below.
