Thank you for keeping my family and me safe.

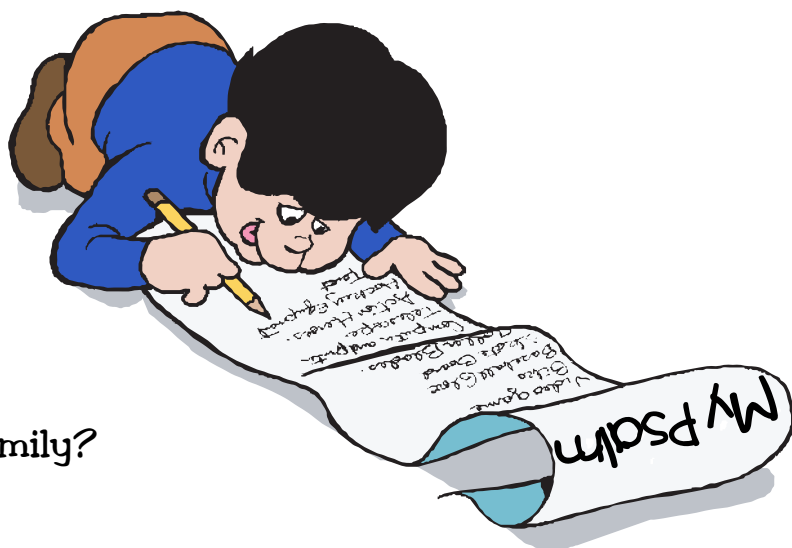
Thank you for our food, home, and church.
