7. Instead of taxing the people, I had a chest made to receive donations so that the temple could be restored. Who am I?

8. I gave about 30,000 lambs and kids of my stock and 3,000 bulls to the people for Passover offerings. Who am I?

9. After the death of Jehoida, I was persuaded to allow the worship of idols again. Who am I?
