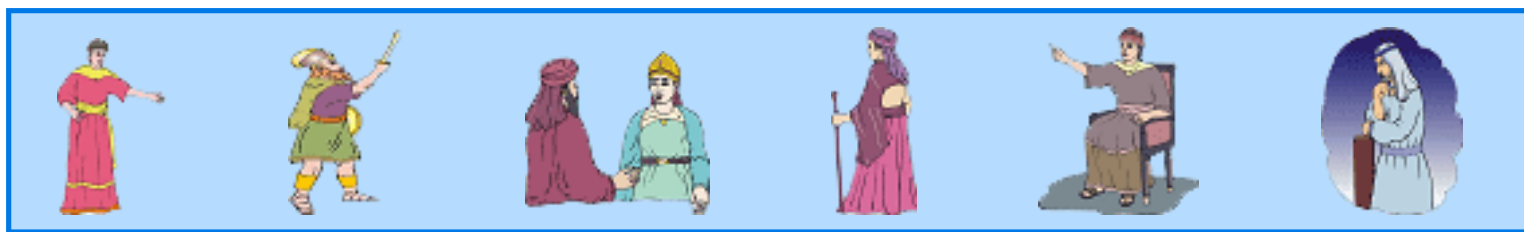


Matching the Kings

- ___ 3. He was known for his wisdom (I Kings 3)
- ___ 4. He slew Goliath before he became King (I Samuel 17)
- ___ 5. He was a terrible king with the longest reign (II Chron. 33:1)
- ___ 6. He had the shortest reign - 7 days (I Kings 16:15)
- ___ 7. He put Daniel in with the lions (Daniel 6)
- ___ 8. He was married to Esther (Esther 7:5)
- ___ 9. He was the youngest King (II Chron 24:1)
- ___ 10. He was the first king of Israel at the divided kingdom (I Kings 14:20)
- ___ 11. He threw the Hebrew boys into a fiery furnace.
- ___ 12. He asked for the sun to move backwards ten degrees. (II Kings 20:9-11)
- ___ 13. Nehemiah asked this King if he could return to Jerusalem to rebuild the walls. (Nehemiah 2:1)
- ___ 14. He was the first king of Judah (I Kings 12:17)
- ___ 15. He tried to kill David, and sought help from a familiar spirit. (I Samuel 28:7)
