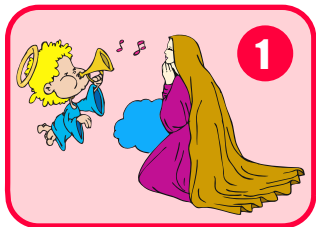


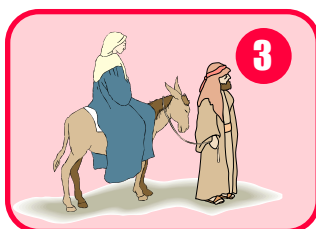
# Nativity Quiz

\_\_\_ 2. An angel told Joseph that the child Mary was carrying would be named Jesus.



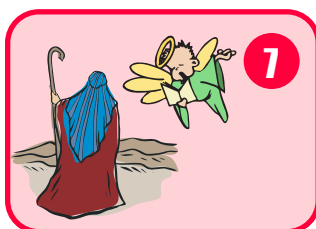
\_\_\_ 3. Joseph and Mary traveled from Bethlehem to Nazareth to pay their taxes.
