This is a drawing of one of the bedrooms in the palace at Shushan, the place where Queen Esther lived. The sixth verse of the first chapter of Esther says: "Where were white, green, and blue, hangings [drapes], fastened with cords of fine linen and purple to silver rings and pillars of marble; the beds were of gold and silver, upon a pavement [floor] of red, and blue, and white, and black marble."
