"Again, you have heard that it was said to those of ancient times, 'You shall not swear <u>falsely</u>, but carry out the <u>vows</u> you have made to the <u>Lord</u>.' But I say to you, Do not <u>swear</u> at all, either by <u>heaven</u>, for it is the <u>throne</u> of God, or by the <u>earth</u>, for it is his <u>footstool</u>, or by <u>Jerusalem</u>, for it is the city of the great <u>King</u>. And do not swear by your <u>head</u>, for you cannot make one <u>hair</u> white or black. Let your word be '<u>Yes, Yes</u>' or '<u>No, No</u>'; anything more than this comes from the evil one.
