

Which Gospel?

Each of the Gospels takes us through the events of the Passion Week, and each Gospel mentions different details. Read the detail on the left and write the name of the Gospel(s) from which it came.

The names can be used more than once and some details will have more than one Gospel match.

It's always important to pay attention to the details!

| MATTHEW | MARK | LUKE | JOHN |

1. Names Peter as the person who cuts off an ear of a servant who came to arrest Jesus.

John

2. Judas betrays Jesus for 30 pieces of silver.

Matthew

3. Jesus heals the servant's ear.

Luke

4. Tells us that the servant's name is Malcus.

John

5. Peter runs to Jesus' tomb and finds only linen cloths – not Jesus.

Luke

6. Jesus is anointed by a woman at Simon's house in Bethany.

Mark and Matthew

7. Mentions a Last Supper or Passover meal.

Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
