## Missionary Journeys of Barnabas, Paul, and Timothy

### 1st Stop - Syrian Antioch

(June) Acts 11:19-26; 13:1-3

- Followers draw Antioch citizens into the Church
- Barnabas and Saul help the Church

### 2nd Stop - Seleucia

(June) Acts 13:4-13

- Missionary journey to Cyprus

### 3rd Stop - Tarsus

(June) Acts 9:26-30; 11:25; 21:39; 22:3

- Where Paul grew up

### 4th Stop - Cappadocia

(July) Acts 2:5-11; I Peter 1

- Fairy chimneys
- Underground cities protect Christians from the Romans

### 5th Stop - Pisidian Antioch

(July) Acts 13:14-52

- Paul preaches to the Jews and Gentiles

### 6th Stop - Iconium

(July) Acts 14:1-7

- The Jews are angry with Paul for preaching to the Gentiles
- A new Christian church would open later

### 7th Stop - Lystra

(August) Acts 14:5-20; 2 Cor 11:25; Gal 6:17; 2 Tim 3:10-11

- The myth of Jupiter and Mercury visiting Lystra
- Paul heals man near the temple
- Paul and Barnabas are attacked, Christian friends provide protection and prayers



### 8th Stop - Lystra (Timothy)

(August) Acts 16:1; Acts 20:4; Phil 2:20,22; 1 Cor 4:17; 1 Cor 16:10; 2 Tim 1:5; 2 Tim 3:14-17

- Paul and Barnabas meet Eunice, Lois, and Timothy
- Timothy helps build a Christian church
- Paul's letters to Timothy

### 9th Stop - Derbe

(August) Acts 14:20-21

- A tour of a small village near Derbe
- The tell of Derbe
- Paul and Barnabas decide to revisit and encourage members of the new churches
