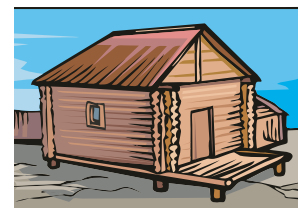
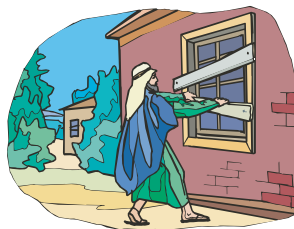
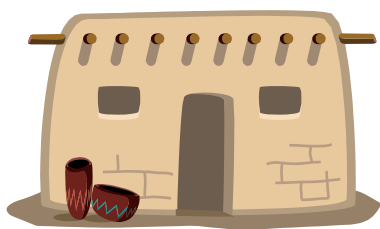


2. The houses in the little town near Derbe are made of:

C. Wood Logs



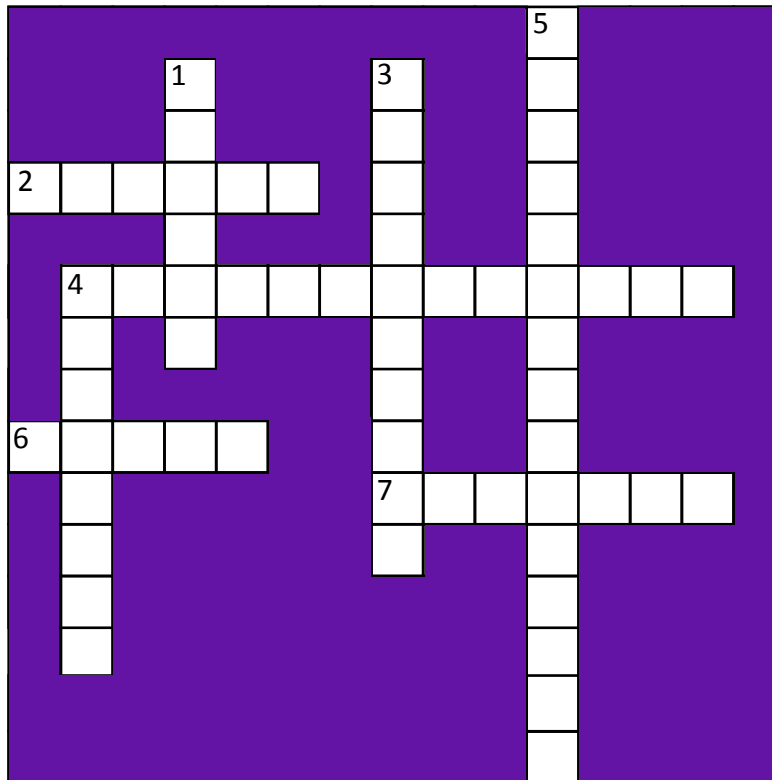
