
## Did You Know this about the disciple Judas?

 His last name was Iscariot.

 He was Jesus' treasurer.  He sold information about where to find Jesus to the chief priest for 30 pieces of silver.

 He objected to Mary of Bethany anointing Jesus' feet a few days before Jesus' crucifixion because he thought she should have sold the expensive perfume and given the money to the poor.

- After betraying Jesus, he returned to eat the Passover meal with Jesus and the disciples.
- He left the meal after Jesus said that one of them would betray him.



## Did You Know this about the disciple Judas?

- While Jesus was in the Garden of Gethsemane, Judas showed up with a crowd – chief priest, temple guards, elders – to arrest Jesus.
- He kissed Jesus so the guards would know which person to arrest.
- He regretted what he had done and died.
